Botox therapy has many uses in dentistry. Your California dental license already permits you to treat various dental related conditions by injecting botulinum toxin (Botox). This course will cover the uses and instructions for botulinum toxins, their history, dosage preparation and injection techniques for a variety of dental related procedures. These include: TMJ pain and muscle spasms, bruxation therapy, lip and masseter muscle contour and treatment of associated migraines. Informed consent and the risks, benefits and alternatives (RBAs) will also be included in this course.



Andrew Blumenfeld, MD, is a neurologist and the director of the Headache Center of Southern California, located in San Diego. He is the Co-director of the Sleep Center of Southern California and a partner in the Research Center of So. Calif. in Oceanside.

Dr. Blumenfeld is chair of the American Headache Soc. Special Section: Peripheral nerve block and other interventional procedures for headaches and facial pain. He served as Chief of Neurology at Kaiser Permanente in San Diego and was the chairman of the bioethics committee. Dr. Blumenfeld has published and taught the use of Botox to health care providers including dentists nationally and internationally and has been treating patients with Botox since 1990.

Dr. James Jesse graduated from Loma Linda University in Southern California in 1973. He has been in private practice in Colton, California for the past 31 years. He lectures nationally as well as internationally on numerous techniques related to laser dentistry, bonding and composites, 3D imaging, cariology, cancer screening, high tech minimally invasive dentistry, digital radiography, general endodontics, and many other techniques and concepts related to the practice of dentistry. In addition, Dr. Jesse is an associate Professor at Loma Linda, teaching Restorative Dentistry and he is an assistant Professor at Columbia University. In addition, he does extensive research with pre-doctorate and graduate students. He also does Forensic Dentistry in San Diego County and is a Deputy Sheriff with San Bernardino County.

Minimally Invasive Endodontics: Post & Core

Synopsis: This program is designed to show with today's technology and diagnostic tools, that dental professionals can be proficient with root canal procedures. Material will be discussed with respect to design criteria and clinical application for post and core.

Course Objectives:

- Preserve the true anatomy of the canals
- Learn the most effective ways to debride the canal
- Review current Endodontic files and their attributes
- Review technologies of past and present Endodontic techniques
- Learn the pros and cons of the latest obturation materials
- Review past and current post materials
- Describe the indication for a post
- Understand the placement techniques of a post
- Discuss the crown preparation after the post and build up

The Perio-Systemic Connection

This course will focus on the prevention of periodontal disease, using sound diagnosis, and the resulting treatment plans in a minimally invasive manner, to ensure predictable results. We will examine oral bacteria and their influence in the process and various modalities for treatment. We will discuss the implications of periodontal disease on total health.

Learning Objectives:

- Learn how to motivate your patients to prevent periodontal disease and accept responsibility for their treatment.
- Learn the pathophysiology of oral disease.
- Learn that the periodontal condition can affect many different areas of the body.
- Learn DNA testing and how it can help in treatment planning.
- Learn to change from the standard surgical procedures to minimally invasive perio treatment, including the use of piezo scalers and lasers.
