The coping methods to allow for successful treatment will be presented including sedation, nitrous oxide analgesia, and treatment under general anesthesia. Pulpal therapy has undergone a number of changes with many practitioners' sadly out of date, so current methods, research and animal studies will also update the attendee to new, promising procedures in pulpal therapy.

This movement has been termed "Biomimetic Dentistry." Dr. Cohen reviews the fundamentals of this shift and shows step-by-step, from start-to-finish how to create biomimetic treatment plans and securely bonded, fail safe restorations that avoid the downsides of full cut-down crowns.

Revolutionary Endo: This seminar covers the latest research and techniques, based on Biomimetic principals of maximizing tooth structure, for having endodontic success in your practice.
