



**Updates in Pediatric Dentistry:** The course will begin with modern concepts of caries management and minimally invasive dentistry. The importance of preventive care in pediatric dentistry cannot be over-emphasized. Diagnostic aids necessary to determine the best methods for prevention will be described and techniques for prevention recommended for the different cases as presented. The apprehensive child patient may be very challenging, and therefore the correct psychological management of these patients must be addressed. There is a substantial number of complicating factors that must be considered with these patients, such as, parenting, societal changes, and stage of development. The coping methods to allow for successful treatment will be presented including sedation, nitrous oxide analgesia, and treatment under general anesthesia. The restorative care of all dental patients require a strong knowledge of dental materials and their applications. The course will present new concepts in adhesion and current research into new dental materials familiarizing the participant with current technology. Pulpal therapy has undergone a number of changes with many practitioners sadly out of date. The discussion of current methods, research and animal studies will update the attendee to new, promising procedures in pulpal therapy.
