DR. PERIKLIS PROUSSAEFS is a prosthodontist. He obtained a certificate in Prosthodontics, a certificate in Implant Dentistry, and a Master's degree from Loma Linda University (LLU) in year 2000. Dr Proussaefs has published over 45 peer-reviewed articles in the dental literature, and has been serving as an Editorial Board member for the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, the Journal of Prosthodontics, and the Journal of Oral Implantology. Among many others, he is the recipient of the prestigious Tylman award by the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics, the Judson C. Hickey Scientific Writing Award by the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, and the Robert James Achievement Award by the Advanced Education program in Implant Dentistry at LLU. Since year 2000, he has been an Assistant Professor at LLU

where he conducts research and seminars.

DR. PROUSSAEFS has received formal training in all forms of sedation since 1997. Part of his residence program at LLU included full time training in general anesthesia. He has been providing dental care for patients under I.V. (moderate) sedation or oral (minimal) sedation having completed thousands of cases. Having tremendous exposure in sedating patients over the years, his seminars will be focused on SAFETY, and in particular airway management, patient monitoring, and handling emergencies. The course involves lecturing, hands-on practicing on a mannequin, and real patient experience. The discussion with the instructor will focus on sharing the instructor's 20 years' experience in sedating dental patients.

Topics Include:* Gain a greater appreciation for diagnosis and assessment of tooth root anatomy and alveolar shape and form ♦ Understanding the socket anatomy based treatment algorithm ♦ Understand how to treatment plan in the best way to reach the desired outcome ♦ Learn the principles of minimally traumatic tooth extraction ♦ Gain an understanding of the biology of ridge resorption after extraction of a tooth ♦ Learn about the biofunctionality of biomaterials and its influence on extraction socket healing ♦ (HANDS-ON) Practice important techniques for minimally invasive tooth extraction plus preparing and placing biomaterials to achieve optimal ridge preservation

Esthetic Peds and Treating Trauma: *This presentation will discuss all aspects of Esthetic Pediatric Dentistry for the demanding patient and parent! Specifically; anterior and posterior composites, esthetic crowns (zirconium and IPS e.max), tissue regeneration, laser therapy, preventive and interceptive orthodontics, esthetic space maintainers, and, of course, behavior management. Dr. Cannon will also provide a comprehensive review of preventive dentistry, using the latest in probiotic therapy and the latest in microbiome research.*
