## **COURSE TOPICS**

Hands-on Pedo (this course IS INCLUDED in the series): This course will cover the common pulp therapy issues in primary teeth, current concepts in materials, minimally invasive dentistry (MID) and anesthesia break-throughs, in Pediatric Dentistry. The topic of pulp therapy will include Biodentine pulpotomies, indirect pulp caps with GIC and the restorative component will discuss new composites and their application in pulp therapy as well as in the slot prep and SDF used as part of the SMART technique. Learn how to minimize a child's disruptive behavior and your stress during anesthesia administration. Attendees will Perform Hands-on: Class I Biodentine pulpotomy restored with GIC  $\diamond$  Class II slot prep restored with GIC using a Matrix system  $\diamond$  Proper technique and placement of Silver Diamine Flouride  $\diamond$  On a propietary typodont, anesthetize a single tooth with efficacy, safety, and comfort, but without producing collateral numbness and possible injury to a child's lips or tongue

Intro to Dental Sleep Medicine (8 CE Units): This course is intended to provide a comprehensive overview of diagnosis and treatment of sleep apnea cases for dentists interested in adding this growth area to their practices.
