Learn how to minimize a child's disruptive behavior and your stress during anesthesia administration. *Attendees will Perform Hands-on:* Class I Biodentine pulpotomy restored with GIC ◆ Class II slot prep restored with GIC using a Matrix system ◆ Proper technique and placement of Silver Diamine Flouride ◆ On a propietary typodont, anesthetize a single tooth with efficacy, safety, and comfort, but without producing collateral numbness and possible injury to a child's lips or tongue
