

## **COURSE TOPICS**

Updates in Pediatric Dentistry: This course features a comprehensive update in Pediatric Dentistry, including: New psychological insights and research on Behavior Guidance, the dental implications for the increase in Autism, preterm births ◆ ADHD caries formation and prevention as well as how to perform a CAMBRA caries risk assessment ◆ How using Xylitol, Fluoride Varnish, MI Paste, Chlorhexadine, and sealants are effective preventive measures ◆ Indirect Pulp Caps and MTA/Biodentine pulpotomies. ◆ New designs in tooth preparation & when to use GIC, RMGI's, and a new flowable composite for Class I to Class V preps ◆ Diagnosis and treatment of simple and complex traumatic injuries in addition to a simple method for splinting.

Oral Medicine for GPs: This course gives dentists the tools to diagnose abnormal and pathological conditions within the mouth. Using clinical pictures and x-ray imaging and by teaching diagnostic process and differential diagnosis (DiffDx), the course addresses systemic health conditions manifesting as oral changes and also possible treatment of oral conditions, including: What a lesion looks like, the general concepts of diagnostics and value of patient histories Appropriate communication with other doctors Review common lesions including, candidiasis, frictional hyperkeratosis, lichen planus, auto-immune diseases manifested in the mouth, apthous ulcers, hemangiomas, hematomas and ecchymosis, HSV 1, HPV and other viral lesions, oral cancers and radiographic lesions.

Intro to Dental Sleep Medicine (8 CE Units): This course is intended to provide a comprehensive overview of diagnosis and treatment of sleep apnea cases for dentists interested in adding this growth area to their practices. Dr. Veis will cover all aspects diagnosis and the sleep study, deciding which appliances to use for treatment, measuring and fitting the appliances, interacting with the fabricating lab, and how to manage the billings to medical insurance, including: Provide an understanding of the scope of the problem and why we need to be at the front lines in its recognition and treatment. ◆ Talk the talk and walk the walk... definitions and terms needed to understand the problem and communicate with your peers. ◆ Learn how to screen every patient in your practice regardless of their age. ◆ The Who, What, When, Where and How of getting a Diagnosis ◆ Overview of treatment possibilities ◆ How to do a thorough exam and why it's critical to choosing the best treatment option ◆ Achieve an understanding of sleep appliances ◆ Working in a team approach and staying within the scope of your practice act ◆ Integrating sleep into your practice...a medical model in a dental practice ◆ Getting paid...services to take care of the medical billing

**Comprehensive Treatment Planning and Care:** This course will cover strategies to help you patients from prevention of dental caries to restorative strategies that offer long-term results. Clinical results and the profit potential of a caries management program alongside comprehensive restorative treatment planning and implementation will be covered. Cases will be discussed in depth and attendees will be able to participate in the evaluation of patients for caries risk, risk management, documentation and restorative treatment.
