Dental Pharmacology with Opioids and Cannabis-What Dentists Should Know: Dentists oversee the treatment and management of acute and chronic pain and relieving anxiety in connection with dental treatment. Increased awareness of the addiction potential of opioids has resulted in many new laws and guidelines for the prescribing of these medications. Although dentists are not usually involved in the prescribing or dispensing of cannabis products, as health care professionals we should have a working knowledge of these substances. Information presented will include: The latest biomedical ramifications of addiction/substance, including the disease model of addiction, biopsychosocial predispositions, and genetic susceptibilities \diamond The concepts of tachyphylaxis (drug tolerance), psychological dependence, physical dependence and the drugs used in the short-term treatment of substance abuse detox-withdrawal syndromes \diamond Opioid use and misuse \diamond New guidelines and laws regarding the prescribing of opioids as well as the DEA scheduling of drugs \diamond The nature of cannabinoids, natural and synthetic \diamond CBD and the OTC CBD oil craze \diamond An understanding of CBD labeled products \diamond The dangers of super-high potency marijuana preparations \diamond Cannabinoid drugs and common side effects as well as adverse effects
