

COURSE TOPICS

Oral Medicine for Dentists: This course gives dentists the tools to diagnose abnormal and pathological conditions within the mouth. Using clinical pictures and x-ray imaging and by teaching diagnostic process and differential diagnosis (DiffDx), the course addresses systemic health conditions manifesting as oral changes and also possible treatment of oral conditions, including: What a lesion looks like, the general concepts of diagnostics and value of patient histories script Appropriate communication with other doctors script ◆ Review common lesions including, candidiasis, frictional hyperkeratosis, lichen planus, auto-immune diseases manifested in the mouth, apthous ulcers, hemangiomas, hematomas and ecchymosis, HSV 1, HPV and other viral lesions, oral cancers and radiograph- ic lesions

Perio for GPs: Crown Lengthening and soft tissue grafts are some of the most commonly required procedures to enhance restorative results, yet they are often underutilized. This course provides evidence based concepts and practical applications for both modalities including: For Crown lengthening - How to handle uneven gingiva in the anterior region ♦ Getting predictable impressions EVERY TIME ♦ Preservation of esthetics in the final tissue contours ♦ Coordinating restorations with surgical interventions. Grafting concepts include - Having the gingiva stay in place by the margins of newly placed esthetic crowns ♦ How Gingival Grafts will create zones of attached gingiva providing a predictable way to stop recession from progressing ♦ How Connective Tissue Grafts can achieve root coverage in cases of severe recession, especially in the maxilla where esthetics are important.

Morphology & Occlusion: Every restoration placed has the potential to alter the occlusal relationship of the patients' dentition. Thus, understanding, visualizing, and reproducing proper dentate morphology following occlusal concepts regardless of the material used is the key to long-lasting dental restoration. In this lecture, Dr. Lowe will review in detail techniques to create dental restorations that show how the principles of morphology and occlusion can be maintained using today's modern dental materials to produce "world class" dental restorations, including: The Principles of Morphology in Direct and Indirect Dental Restorations − Reproducing nature's functional and aesthetic contours − A basis of occlusal understanding. ◆ The importance of "linguovision" in understanding occlusion. ◆ The "ABC" Porkorny Construct of Occlusal Contact: What do those "little dots" mean? ◆ Occlusal Adjustment or "Spheroiding": Maintaining morphologic shape and form when performing occlusal adjustment. ◆ The Art and Science of Provisionalization: A biologic and occlusal prototype for definitive reconstruction. ◆ Tissue Management During Master Impressions: "Tissue Mirrors Technique!" ◆ Definitive cementation protocols for conventional, bioactive, and resin cements: Occlusal adjustment during the cementation process. ◆ Combined Therapy and "Perio-by-the-Numbers" The perioprosthetic connection to restorative dentistry. ◆ Creative Treatment Options: Abstracting Reality! Solutions to aesthetic and functional dental problems you probably have not considered.

Dental Pharmacology with Opioids and Cannabis-What Dentists Should Know: Dentists oversee the treatment and management of acute and chronic pain and relieving anxiety in connection with dental treatment. Increased awareness of the addiction potential of opioids has resulted in many new laws and guidelines for the prescribing of these medications. Although dentists are not usually involved in the prescribing or dispensing of cannabis products, as health care professionals we should have a working knowledge of these substances. Information presented will include: The latest biomedical ramifications of addiction/substance, including the disease model of addiction, biopsychosocial predispositions, and genetic susceptibilities ◆ The concepts of tachyphylaxis (drug tolerance), psychological dependence, physical dependence and the drugs used in the short-term treatment of substance abuse detox-withdrawal syndromes ◆ Opioid use and misuse ◆ New guidelines and laws regarding the prescribing of opioids as well as the DEA scheduling of drugs ◆ The nature of cannabinoids, natural and synthetic ◆ CBD and the OTC CBD oil craze ◆ An understanding of CBD labeled products ◆ The dangers of super-high potency marijuana preparations ◆ Cannabinoid drugs and common side effects as well as adverse effects
