Dental Pain Management of Patients with Common Medical Conditions and Prescribing Opioids (8CE Units): *Medical advances have enabled patients who were treated only in hospital-based clinics, to come to our private dental practices. Objectives Include: Confidently assess & manage ambulatory dental patients with cardiovascular disease, diabetes, COPD, bleeding disorders and on anticoagulant therapy, hepatitis, HIV, organ transplants and osteoporosis & Precautions for patients on medications that manage their conditions and drug interactions & Understanding Practices for Pain Management in Dentistry & Procedures for Managing Vulnerable or Substance Use Disorder Patients & Become Familiar with Regulatory Requirements for Prescribers and Dispensers-New guidelines and laws regarding the prescribing of opioids as well as the DEA scheduling of drugs*

Dental Implants for GPs: *Dr. Fraser demystifies implant dentistry & shows offices how to integrate this vital procedure into their practice. More importantly, he shows how to make implant dentistry cost-effective, efficient, and affordable for patients. After all, people want teeth - not dental implants! Designed for the general dentist, attendees will learn the importance of treatment planning, diagnostics, and radiographic interpretation. This course covers procedures such as single tooth replacement, overdentures, and multiple tooth replacement in easy-to-follow, step-by-step protocols.
