COURSE TOPICS

OSHA, Infection Control and the CA Dental Practice Act: This course will not only entertain you and your staff but will enable attendees to meet license renewal requirements and state and federal requirements for OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen training, and Infection Control. Esthethic Rehabilitation of the Worn Dentition & Adhesive Ceramic Restorations on both Teeth & Implants: This presentation covers the importance of a differential diagnosis for the worn dentition, a step-by-step approach how to diagnose, treatment plan and sequence esthetic rehabilitation of patients with severe worn dentition. Objectives include: Understanding smile design, bonded esthetic prototypes, * Learning all ceramic system selection based on functional needs, adhesive system selection, and bonding sequence, with a focus on occlusal management in order to minimize porcelain fractures and complications Bonded indirect restorations on teeth and implants have many applications in esthetic dentistry. This segment presents strategies for the best outcomes, including: Discuss the application of analog & digital workflows, CAD-CAM, and adhesive technologies in esthetic dentistry * Explain how to select and integrate restorative materials and adhesive protocols for indirect ceramic restorations

Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office: The risk for medical emergencies is only growing as our patient populations are growing older and living longer with serious coronary, respiratory, autoimmune, and neoplastic disease but there are steps we can take to minimize the chances of an adverse event. The first step is to identify and assess the medical conditions of our patients and reduce the risk of a practice-changing event. The next step is to know how to identify and respond to minor and significant medical emergencies. This response involves having an office emergency plan in place and making sure that every member of the practice team knows their role and knows what to do. Course objectives include:

Have the tools and knowledge to evaluate their patients' medical histories and determine the impact of that information on their performance of dental treatment for that person • Understand what medication the patient may be taking to treat their medical condition and how that will affect their care of that patient and what medications can and cannot be prescribed • Be able to recognize the type of medical emergency that is occurring • Have a predetermined course of action to treat the emergency quickly and correctly so that the risk of the emergency becoming life-threatening is reduced • Know what medications and supplies should be in the emergency kit for every office and know how to properly use these tools • Understand the importance of an office emergency plan and assignment of staff roles before the unexpected happens • Know when to call 911 and when it is not necessary • Understand the reporting requirements of most state Dental Boards.


