Restoring Your Confidence in Pediatric Care (Lecture): An extensive review of all procedures in pediatric restorative dentistry, including: Diagnosis (Clinical and Radiographic), treatment planning (including cases that participants diagnose and treatment plan from bitewing x-rays), primary anterior and permanent posterior restorations, primary pulp therapy, stainless steel crowns, anterior strip crowns and preventive restorations with air abrasion technology.
