A graduate of Washington University School of Dental Medicine, Dr. Duane Keller has maintained a private practice in St. Louis, MO since 1976. In addition to general dentistry, Dr. Keller works with physicians and therapists to provide non-surgical therapy for periodontal disease and chronic TMD. As the chief scientific officer for the IAO, Dr. Keller has lectured to national and international audiences for 20 years and published over 35 articles in professional journals, most recently a case study in DPR (July, 2010). Over the years he has patented numerous dental devices and treatment methodologies. In 2004 the FDA cleared the Perio-Tray for the placement of theraputic solutions into periodontal pockets.



Program Synopsis: The minimally invasive Perio-Protect Method combines mechanical and chemical therapies to disrupt biofilm growth. Oral biofilms are particularly difficult to treat because the bacterial community creates a slimy layering of matrix materials that form a protective covering. The bacterial community can also share defensive strategies and resistance to conventional antibiotics. The objective of the Method is to break up the matrix and change the microbiological environment of the pockets to disrupt the growth of the biofilms.

In order to place an oral debriding agent into periodontal pockets, a custom-formed prescription tray, like the Perio-Tray, is necessary. At this program Dr. Keller will present the science behind the Method and demonstrate how oral debriding agents, delivered in a customized prescription tray, can dissolve the matrix, debride the biofilm layer by layer, and modify the anaerobic environment of periodontal pockets for significant pathogen reductions.




