

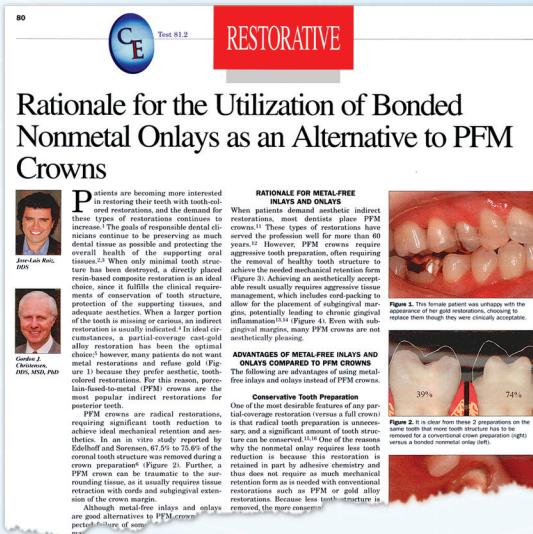

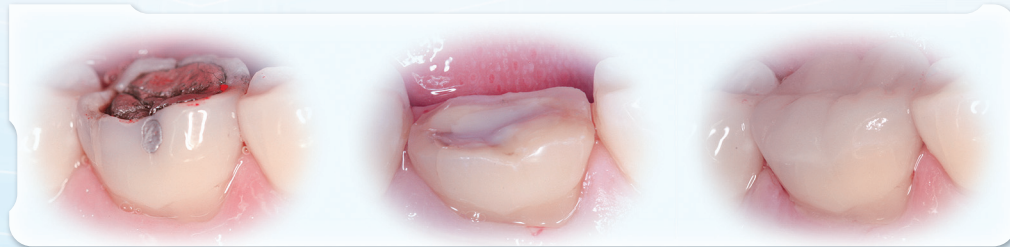
Excellence with Posterior Indirect Non-Metal Restorations



Patients are becoming more interested in restoring their teeth with tooth color restorations. When a larger part of the tooth is missing or decayed, an indirect restoration is usually used. In ideal circumstances a partial coverage cast gold alloy restoration is the ideal choice, but many patients don't want metal in their mouth or refuse them because they prefer a white restoration. Dr. Ruiz will cover benefits, indication, principles of tooth preparation for posterior metal free inlays, onlays, and all porcelain crowns and FPD. Dr. Ruiz will also discuss patient education and motivation for this type of dentistry.
