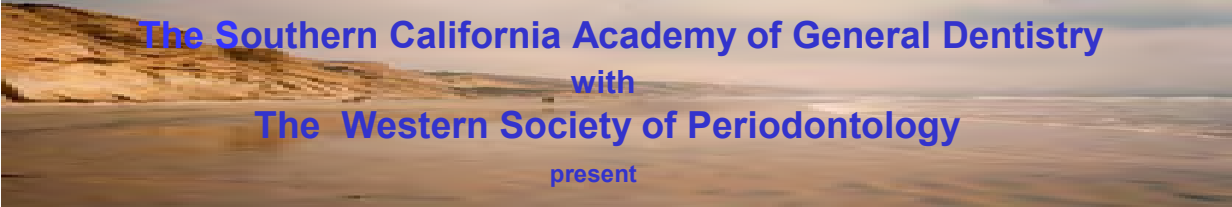

Gerald Drury, MS, DDS, FACD is the past chairman of the American Board of Periodontology, editor of the Journal of the Western Society of Periodontology, clinical professor & course director, Advanced Periodontology at USC, past-president of the California Society of Periodontists and current president of the Western Society of Periodontology. He practices in Hermosa Beach.

Subject: Maintaining ideal health around teeth and dental implants.



Since January, 1998 California law requires all patients "of record" to have a medical history, a specific diagnosis and treatment plan and a periodontal evaluation with pocket charting, performed by either the primary care provider (GP) or a periodontist. For the complex-comprehensive cases a dedicated-detailed written treatment plan is recommended as opposed to a "fill-in-the-blanks" office form. Standards of care are constantly evolving, as you will learn about at this presentation given by four periodontist experts who will explain the four categories of periodontal treatment that you need to know about with every patient in order to practice within the standard of care.

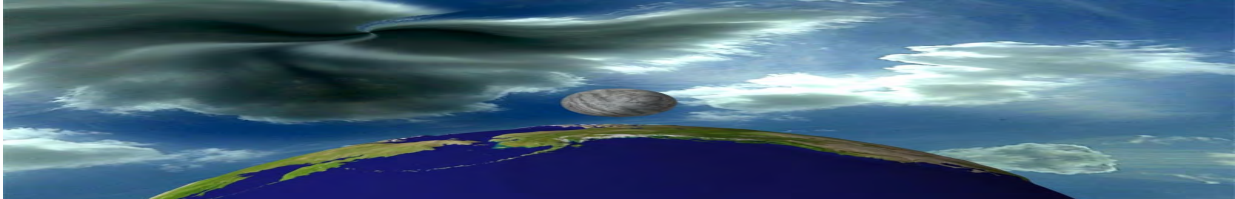

At this March 11, 2012 CE course you will learn:

1. How periodontal diseases and oral inflammation have been linked to systemic diseases such as cardiovascular, respiratory, diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, osteoporosis/osteopenia and adverse pregnancy outcomes. We will review systemic diseases and their correlation with periodontal disease and implant therapy. Clinical application will be emphasized.
2. Knowing how to correctly diagnose and communicate this to patients is vital and may save lives. When working together with periodontists we are truly improving total body health.
3. The current state of periodontal therapy will be important in understanding how to apply the various treatment modalities tailored to each individual patient's circumstances.
4. Today, dental implants have the potential to be very predictable. Do they really have a better prognosis than natural teeth? When do you "give up" and remove and replace periodontally compromised teeth with dental implant restorations? Is maintenance of dental implant similar to maintaining teeth? How to apply implants to these cases is a "scientific art" that is now the standard of care in dentistry. Take notice; take action!

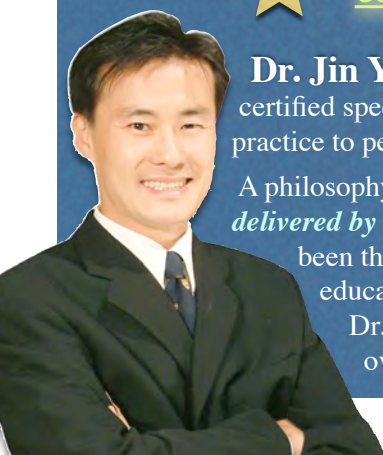

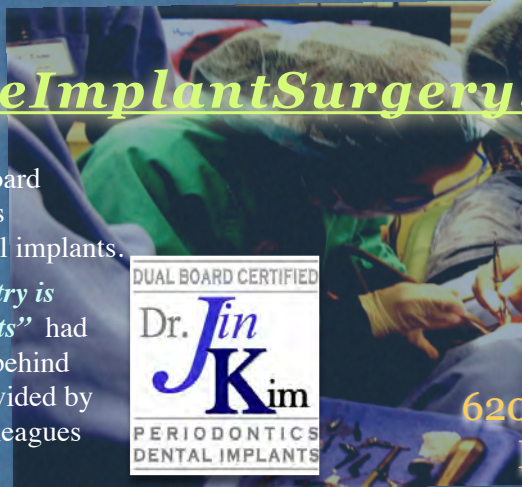

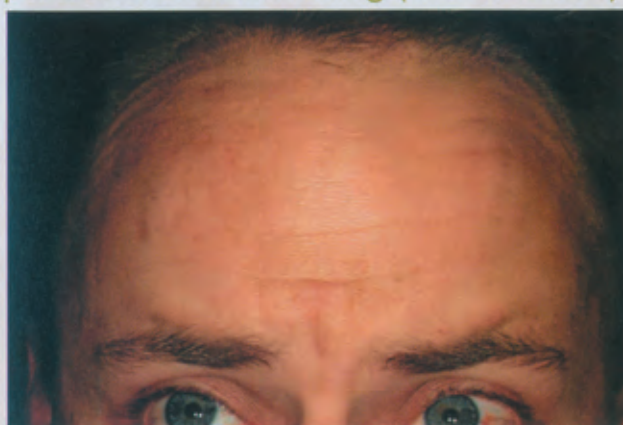
