





This workshop will concentrate on two areas. 1) How to incorporate new endodontic material science into your practice, and 2) How to perform root-canal therapy in such a manner that you can actually enhance the long-term prognosis of teeth. The goal of this program is to have all attendees learn how to perform endodontics in such a manner that they can offer their patients a predictable long-term natural dentition option as an alternative to just removing the tooth and placing an implant.

Of course, as you will learn, clinical judgment plays a key role in the treatment planning of these cases. Included in the lecture component will be a thorough discussion concerning access, non-surgical ultrasonic use, rotary file design, instrumentation techniques and a new bioceramic obturation method. Particular emphasis will be placed on developing endodontic synchronicity between a machined preparation and a laser verified master bioceramic coated cone. Additionally, a new obturation technique (Synchronized Hydraulic Condensation) will be introduced and all participants will have the opportunity to validate these concepts during the hands-on session.

The hands-on session provides you the opportunity to use "Real World" techniques and to witness first-hand how they will change the way you practice endodontics. Time will also be dedicated to preventing the separation (breakage) of rotary files, and the use of piezo-electric ultrasonics. We intend to give you the facts so that you can decide the best way for you to do endodontic therapy.

Botox therapy has many uses in dentistry. Your California dental license already permits you to treat various dental related conditions by injecting botulinum toxin(Botox). This course will cover the uses and instructions for botulinum toxins, their history, dosage preparation and injection techniques for a variety of dental related procedures. These include: TMJ pain and muscle spasms, bruxation therapy, lip and masseter muscle contour and treatment of associated migraines. Informed consent and the risks, benefits and alternatives (RBAs) will also be included in this course.

Andrew Blumenfeld, MD, is a neurologist and the director of the Headache Center of Southern California, located in San Diego. He is the Co-director of the Sleep Center of Southern California and a partner in the Research Center of So. Calif. in Oceanside.
