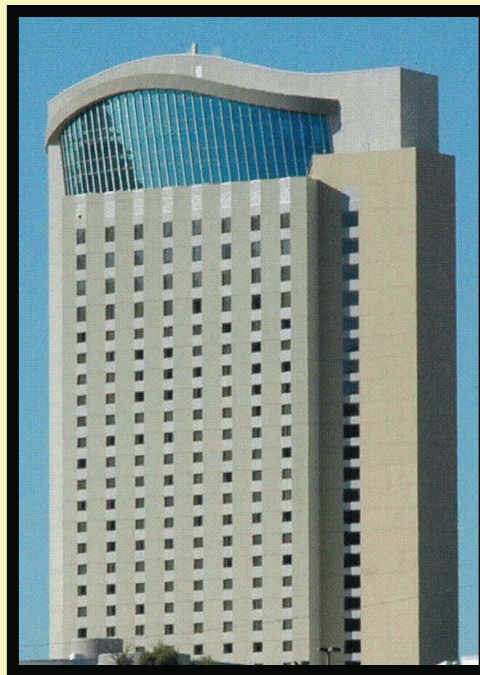

Dr. Snyder attended three years of college at the University of California at Riverside, foregoing the last year and a Bachelor of Science Degree to enroll early into dental school.
